

## **FAN/Forest Hills Meeting November 7, 2007**

### **Meeting schedule**

Should FAN have meetings every month? Discussion ensued about the repetitive nature of meetings and how we might communicate more efficiently with email in case of a critical issue arose. It was moved that FAN have regular meetings January, February, March, April, May (June, July, and August off), September, October, November (December off).

### **Forest Hills**

Forest Hills announced that they are moving to City Council and are ready to amend the FAN plan to include the new addition on the Forest Hills plan.

Lisa Shaw-Ryan spoke about the proposed project at the corner 9th and F. Norma Peterson proposes a 6 unit cottage type community on her double lot. Currently the R-6 code does not allow that type of development through the current code or through the variance process, conditional use or "spot zone". Our current code specifically does not allow increased density in the R-6. A process to change or rezone FAN would be a lengthy public process that would have to be initiated by planning commission which has no plans at this time.

Carole Ockert and Maria Menighan will be applying for a neighborhood enhancement grant to put an entry sign at the forest hills neighborhood entry point, as well as sign caps on the tops of signs similar to the FAN sign caps. The deadline to apply is Dec 7th.

### **Storm Water Issues**

Lisa asked Jim Bolland about the 'adopt a storm drain' program... He is also going to talk to the maintenance department at the City and see if we can get a schedule on the street sweeper so we can be more efficient about moving cars for more effective cleaning.

### **New Construction and Trees**

A question was raised about the City following up with new construction about the mitigation process, planting mitigation trees, etc... This question will be addressed at the January FAN meeting.

### **Additional Topics for Next Meeting**

We will also address striping at the stop signs so cars have a visual reminder.
